Fire Department Donations



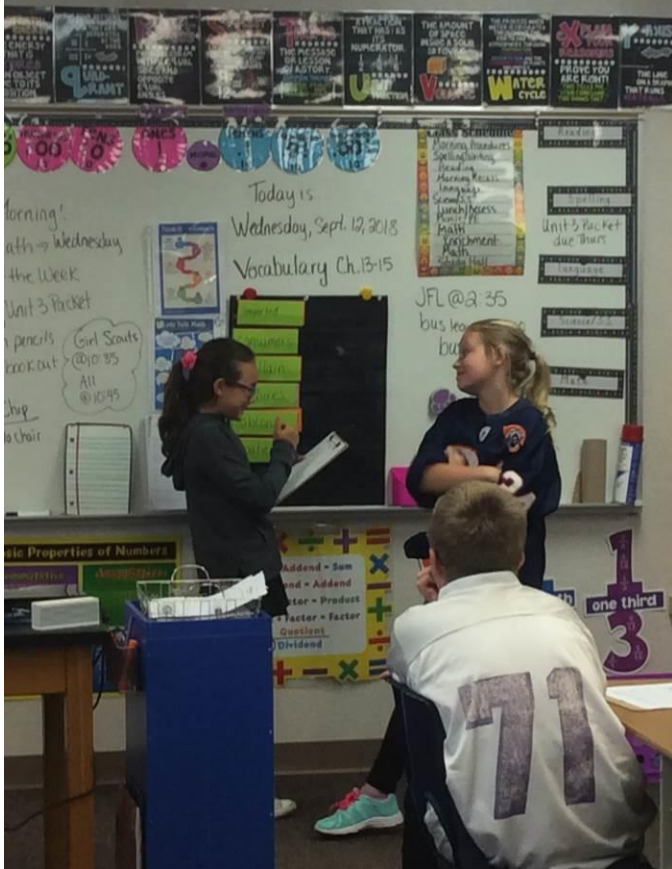
